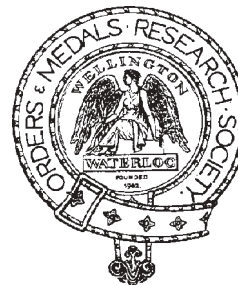

ISSUE 34 July 2007

### MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE ORDERS AND MEDALS RESEARCH SOCIETY (RIBBON BRANCH) HELD ON SATURDAY 9<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2007.

The President opened the meeting at 13:15hrs. There were 9 members present. Apologies were offered from Alan McDonald and Derek Richardson.

Agenda Item 1. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

Agenda Item 2. Annual Reports from Committee Officers: The gist of the reports are as follows.

Secretary. Still getting a lot of request for British ribbons or for ribbon identification from the public/membership. Foreign Ribbon Bank to be reduced in size. The OMRS web site has been removed for overhauling. With it went our new Ribbon Branch site. Membership to be informed when OMRS site is available.

The Editor. (read by the Secretary) Whilst pleased to be The Editor, was very conscious of the lack of interest shown by branch members in research or submitting articles for the Ribbon Collector. Felt there was a need to access the Branch Library to enable the identification of some of the RSS ribbons. Also felt that the branch needed to start to refresh itself with new ideas and younger members.

Membership Secretary. Membership had grown slightly since last year. Current status is 36 UK members and 13 overseas members. Membership Secretary would produce an information sheet for the OMRS Membership Secretary who would send it to all new members of the society in an attempt to increase branch membership. (see note 1)

Guille Collection Project Officer. David Rucker explained that he had now completed the task of photocopying the Guille Collection. This is now bound in A4 volumes. The President thanked David and Edwina on behalf of the committee and the membership for their personal drive and enthusiasm in achieving such a mammoth task. (See item 6)

The Treasurer. The Statement of Accounts (attached) were explained in detail. This year saw a deficit of £113.28 due to a number of items. The statement was unanimously adopted.

Agenda Item 3. Increase of Branch Subscriptions. As part of his presentation, the Treasurer highlighted the increase in hire of rooms/lockers, publication costs of the Ribbon Collector, increased postal charges and the decrease in membership. To sustain the branch for the future, an increase of £4.00 was necessary. This increase would be for all three memberships and would be effective from this July. New subscriptions are therefore; UK £12.00, Europe £14.00 and The Rest of the World £18.00. This increase was unanimously adopted. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU HAVE ALREADY PAID AT THE OLD RATE, PLEASE EITHER SEND A NEW CHEQUE FOR THE NEW AMOUNT OR THE ADDITION.** All subscriptions to be sent to: Mr SL Duffy, 6 Parks Leys, Harlington, Dunstable, Bedfordshire LU5 6LY by the end of July 2007.

Agenda Item 4. The future production of the Ribbon Collector. Various suggestions were raised for reducing the cost of the Ribbon Collector; distribution by e-mail, keeping to the agreed size, having a designated cost per edition, having the master copy produced and distributed in the UK and keeping to a reasonable size were just some of the suggestions. The Committee agreed that the matter would be looked into and further guidance and assistance given to the Editor where possible. All related correspondence with the Editor would be a binding part of these minutes.



Agenda Item 5. Election of the Branch Committee. The election of the committee for the coming year was voted on as follows:

Agenda Item 6. The Guille Collection CD. Having now created the information electronically, the task of producing a CD was relatively straightforward. A copy of the CD would be free to all members. It had also been agreed by the Executive Committee that it would also be advertised through the OMRS Journal and sold at the Annual Convention with proceeds going to the branch. David went on to explain that the 'end plan' was to have the Guille, Fforde and The (Sid Wood) Permanent Collections sorted by country on a CD set. A copy of this CD set would be sent to the Editor as part of his office.

Agenda Item 7. The proposal is to have a bar suspended Branch Medal for issue to both the Ribbon and Miniature branch. Because of the change in the original specification, Rene Verkuijlen has had to meet the company producing the medal again it to discuss costs etc. The plan is to produce 100 silver medals. A percentage of these would be silver gilt with a separate ribbon to denote each branch. Silver Gilt Medals would be awarded for Merit/MSM whilst the Silver Medal for Long service. Rene to present the full cost of the medals to the Committee at the 2007 Convention, where a decision would be made.

Agenda Item 8. Honorary Membership. It was agreed that due to the size of the membership, two members would be permitted to hold the appointment of Honorary Membership of the Branch.

Agenda Item 9. Dates for Next Year's Meetings. The following dates were submitted: Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2008, 19<sup>th</sup> April, 21<sup>st</sup> June and 22 November.

Agenda Item 10. The Branch Library. The Secretary would prune down the contents of the library so as to keep books relating to medal ribbons. Once catalogued, a list would be sent out to the membership. Loan terms would be for periods not exceeding 3 months (request to extend would be to the Secretary) and P&P agreed by the borrower prior to load. Unwanted books would be disposed of by sale either at the annual convention or postal auction to be arranged once the library has been sorted out.

Agenda Item 11. Ribbon Branch Membership Cards. It was agreed that the reissue of Ribbon Branch Membership Cards would take place during 2007. Treasurer to take the lead on this issue.

Agenda Item 12. Any Other Business. The President reminded the membership that:

- The 17<sup>th</sup> November was the annual branch auction and that as much help with lots was needed to inject funds into the branch account. (see Note 2) Please note the time lines in the recent issue of the Ribbon Collector.
- The Branch page in the OMRS Journal needs supporting with a single page input from the member covering ribbons/emblems highlighting the hobby. Details to Steve Duffy.
- Articles for the Ribbon Collector are always needed from the membership. Please do not leave it all up to the Editor.
- Branch meeting times, Room bookings for 2007/08 would be 12:00 hrs to 16:00 hrs. Formal meetings would start at 1300hrs. Those members who wished to use the bar facilities, the library or the collections could do so between 1200hrs and 1300hrs. A designated key holder would be available from 1200hrs.
- The Henry Pownall Chalice Competition. The President suggested that the April meeting each year be set aside for this competition. Open to all members (Secretary is happy to accept and display members entries) Rules; The footprint of the display must be no larger than 4 x A4 sheets of paper. Must be accurate and include some element of research in the exhibit. Judging would be done by secret ballot of those present. In the event of a draw, a member would be discreetly nominated to cast the final vote. The winner would hold the chalice for one year.



Note 1. Under current UK Data Protection Laws it is illegal to produce and distribute collective personal details. In an attempt to overcome this ruling, the Membership Secretary will invite the membership to submit their names, interests and e-mail contact address. This will be distributed to the membership. Once complete and with the agreement of all involved, it will be distributed to the members of the branch. These details are for branch members only and should not be passed onto anyone outside the branch or society with out the expressed permission of the person concerned.

Note 2. Due to the possible delay of the Ribbon Collector containing details of the November auction, it was decided that the admin details for this event would be dealt with from the UK by the Committee.

There being nothing further to discuss, the meeting closed at 1545hrs.

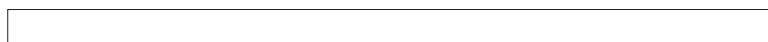

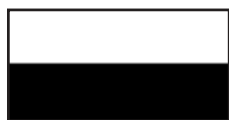
